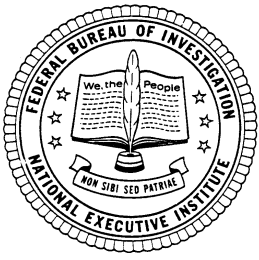

Dear NEI Graduate,

As the newly elected president of the FBI NEIA, I want to take this opportunity to express our appreciation for the support you have given us this past year. During the past several years, we have tried to energize our mission; a mission that fosters fraternity but primarily a continuation of the educational/training of both domestic and international law enforcement chief executives. During the past two years we conducted surveys of active and lapsed members in order to implement a more effective communication process. The Newsletter has received a positive response and is a result of that effort. A number of other initiatives are also in play. Retention of membership has been problematic given that NEI graduates are almost always at the top of their careers. As a result they are subsequently in a retired or second private sector career mode. We are proud to have a membership with that experience and talent. Given such operating circumstances, we have committed ourselves to educational excellence. An example would be the tentative program presentation scheduled for our Sun Valley, June 12-16, 2011. We will be putting on a series of lecture/panel/debate presentations involving domestic radicalism and enforcement of illegal immigration. We are hopeful of having a presentation involving the circumstances and lessons learned from a major city that suffered the murders of four officers in a single day. In addition, we will have a presentation from the New York City Police Department describing the lessons learned from two of their major exercises modeled on the three day terrorist attack in Mumbai, India. Another presentation will be on radicalization and domestic terrorism.

I might add that last year we were able to compress our training schedule to accommodate those attending the Major Cities Chiefs meeting. Their members were able to conduct their meetings and still attend our training sessions. Many of you have been members of both organizations and are aware that we neither conflict nor compete but rather complement each other's organizational responsibilities. In order to reduce the difficulties our international members have saying active, we are exploring the possibility of having a third training conference in Europe. Have a third conference abroad is one of two new goals that we wish to pursue. The second is the creation of some form of "Think Tank" mechanism based in Sun Valley. Presently, the wish is the father of the deed. But the type of executive talent we have, active and retired, should encourage us to pursue knowledge if not solutions to problems that are continual, unexpectedly urgent or simply unthinkable.

If you or someone you know is not current in his/her NEIA membership, I encourage you to reconnect with your fellow graduates. We are a body of relationships, personal
